Educational Purpose

- ▶ Foster self-development skills, based on a wide spectrum of cultural knowledge and virtuous morality.
- ▶ Foster creative work capability that allows one to adapt to a diversifying workfield, based on professional knowledge and skill sets.
- ▶ Foster a democratic citizenship to contribute to the growth of community, based on cooperation and community service.

History

- ▶ As of February 2022, the 43rd graduation ceremony has been held, with 1,856 professional BA degrees and 292 BA degrees conferred (accumulated degrees: 80,564 professional BA degrees and 1,233 BA degrees)
- ▶ Collaborating interscholastic programs with 39 schools in 9 countries (US, Canada, Australia, China, Russia, Japan, Thailand, Philippines, Mongolia)
- ▶ As of April 2022, there are 6,000 students in 5 colleges, 4 majors, and 18 departments.

Eligibility

1. Admission Requirements

Category	Requirements (Applicants must fulfill one of the below conditions)
International applicants whose both parents hold foreign nationality	Domestic and International graduates (to-be) of Primary and Secondary Education
International students who have completed full curricula overseas	Those who graduated from foreign primary to high school educational institutions or those with an equivalent educational background.

- ※ Applicants with Korean dual nationalities are not eligible
- ※ Applicants whose parents are both foreigners must also hold foreign nationality themselves and should be graduates (or expected graduates) of high school in Korea or abroad
- ※ Foreign university qualification exams, Homeschooling, Cyber education are not recognized to be qualified

2. Language Requirements

Language Requirements

Level 3 or higher in TOPIK(Test of Proficiency in Korean) authorized by National Institute for International Education

- ※ Applicants in Korean Government Scholarship Program or Foreign Government Scholarship Programs can apply regardless of TOPIK (Test of Proficiency in Korean) achievements.
- ※ For overseas Koreans with an F visa, application and matriculation is possible even without TOPIK level 3, given that the student has proven to have no linguistic problems in the application interview. the student must then submit their TOPIK grades after matriculation.

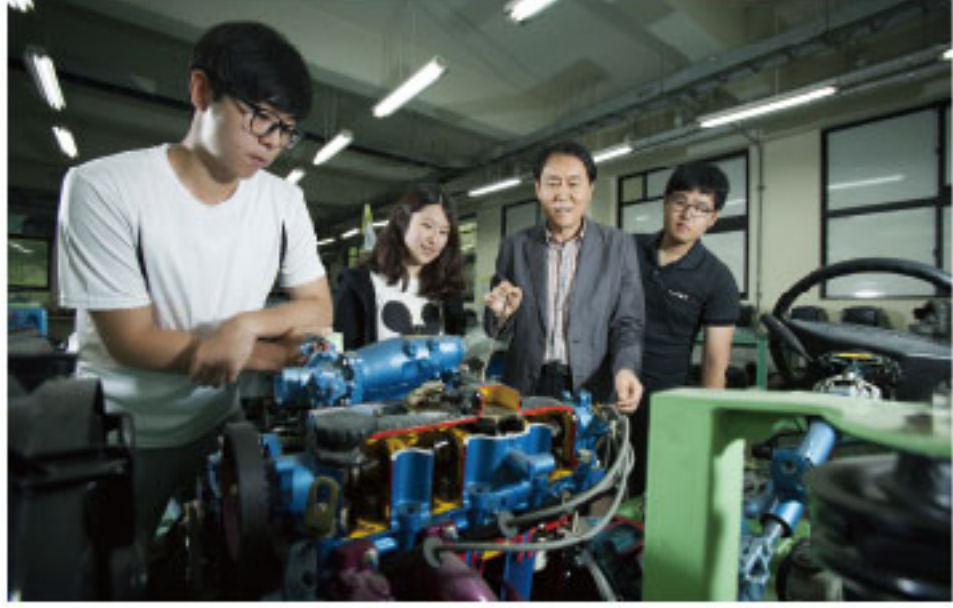
As of 2022, Dong Seoul University selects Foreign students for regular courses, but does not provide any language courses.

Dept. of Aerospace & Mechanical Engineering

Dept. of Computer Software

Dept. of Architecture



Aims to nurture professionals in the field of architecture that can actively and creatively cope with the changing knowledge information society.

Dept. of Computer Information

- 1) If submitted documents are in foreign languages other than English, attach the translation
- 2) Certificate of graduation from final school (certificate of degree/diploma) : in case of citizens of the 21 countries noted by the Minister of Justice* or holders of degrees(diploma) in academic institutes of said countries must use the following methods to get notarized translations.
 - ① Certificate of degree / diploma, certified with Apostille.
 - ② Certificate of degree / diploma with consular confirmation from either: the Korean Consulate in the country in which the school is located, OR the Embassy (or Consulate) in Korea of the country in which the school is located.
 - ③ People's Republic of China: certified academic credentials report issued by the academic credentials certification center operated by the Chinese Ministry of Education (only for holders of degree/diploma in China).
- 3) Applicants are required to submit all documents above, and may be requested to submit additional documents for further confirmation.
